S.R.O. (1)/2020.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 25 of the Civil Servant Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973) read with Notification No. S.R.O. 120(I)/98, dated the 27th February, 1998, the Prime Minister is pleased to direct that the following further amendments shall be made in the Accommodation Allocation Rules, 2002, namely:-

In the aforesaid Rules-

- (a) In Rule 15, sub Rule 2(b), the word un-married shall be deleted.
- (b) In Rule 28, the word Federal Government shall be substituted with Minister In-charge. The Minister-in-charge may, from time to time, issue such directions not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules as he may deem necessary to carry out the purposes of these rules.






No. F. 2(1)/86-Policy.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 25 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973) read with Fundamental Rules 45 and 45-A, the Competent Authority is pleased to direct that in the Accommodation Allocation Rules, 2002, the following further amendments shall be made, namely: -

In the aforesaid Rules in Rule 3, for Sub-Rule (4) the following shall be substituted, namely: -

"(4) Persons employed on contract in Government pay scale in an eligible Government department mentioned in sub-rule (1) shall be eligible in accordance with terms and conditions of his appointment for allotment of Government accommodation or hired accommodation.

Provided that no Federal Government Servant re-employed after superannuation on contract against any position in any government organization, attached department or autonomous body shall be eligible for allotment or retention of Government's accommodation."




